NEW INJECTOR MISTAKE

A quality course will:

- ✓ Teach you foundational techniques so you feel comfortable injecting real patients
- ✓ Help you understand facial anatomy, patient assessment, and safety (because injecting isn't just about technique—it's about knowing when NOT to inject!)
- ✓ Give you hands-on experience so you're not just watching but actually injecting

How to Choose the *Right* Aesthetic Training Program

Not all training programs are created equal. Some will set you up for success. Others? A waste of time and money. Here's **how to evaluate a program** and find the best fit for your goals.

01 Class Size & Student-to-Instructor Ratio

The best way to learn is **by doing**, not by sitting in an overcrowded room. Smaller class sizes mean **more hands-on practice, more instructor feedback, and a better learning experience.**

WHAT TO LOOK FOR:

- ✓ A **4:1 student-to-instructor ratio** or better
- ✓ Instructors who give **personalized feedback** while you inject
- ✓ A training where **every student gets ample hands-on time**

RED FLAG ALERT:

- ✗ A huge class where you barely get to touch a syringe
- ✗ “Hands-on” training where you only observe



PRO-TIP:

Online courses and observation can build your foundation—but nothing replaces picking up the syringe yourself. Hands-on practice is where real confidence is built.

02 Hands-On Training: The Gold Standard

Watching someone else inject **isn't** the same as doing it yourself. The best courses give you **real hands-on** experience with real models.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR:

- ✓ Guaranteed **hands-on** practice (*not just "if time allows"*)
- ✓ At least **2-3 models (or more)** per session
- ✓ Training with **real FDA-approved products** (*not just saline or practice syringes*)

RED FLAG ALERT:

- ✗ A program that says "*you might get to inject*" but doesn't guarantee it
- ✗ Hands-on practice that's *one model per student*—that's not enough to build confidence



PRO-TIP:

If your first real injection is on a paying patient, you weren't trained properly.

03 Instructor Credentials: Who's Teaching You?

Your trainers should be actual experts, not just "certified trainers" with no real-world experience.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR:

- ✓ **Board-certified medical professionals** who actively practice aesthetics
- ✓ Trainers who are **respected in the industry** (KOLs, speakers, published experts)
- ✓ A track record of **teaching successful injectors**

RED FLAG ALERT:

- ✗ A trainer who *only* teaches but doesn't actually see patients
- ✗ A course focused more on selling products than on **clinical excellence**



PRO-TIP:

If you can't find much about your instructor's real-world experience, **that's a red flag**.

04 Reputation & Reviews: Do Your Homework

If real injectors aren't recommending it, **that's a problem.**

WHAT TO LOOK FOR:

- ✓ Reviews from **licensed medical professionals** (not just influencers)
- ✓ Success stories and **before/after work from past students**
- ✓ Word-of-mouth recommendations in **aesthetic forums or professional groups**

RED FLAG ALERT:

- ✗ Multiple complaints about **overcrowding, rushed training, or lack of hands-on experience**
- ✗ No real reviews from actual injectors



PRO-TIP:

Social media is your friend—look for **real students sharing their experience** on Instagram, Facebook, or Reddit.

05 Ongoing Support & Mentorship

Training shouldn't end when you walk out the door. You need ongoing support to grow in this industry.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR:

- ✓ **Access to an alumni network or mentorship program**
- ✓ The ability to **shadow, ask follow-up questions, or retake key sections**
- ✓ Advanced courses for **continued learning**

RED FLAG ALERT:

- ✗ A program that takes your money and **disappears**—no follow-up, no support



PRO-TIP:

The best injectors **keep learning**. If a training offers **mentorship**, it's a sign they actually care about your success.

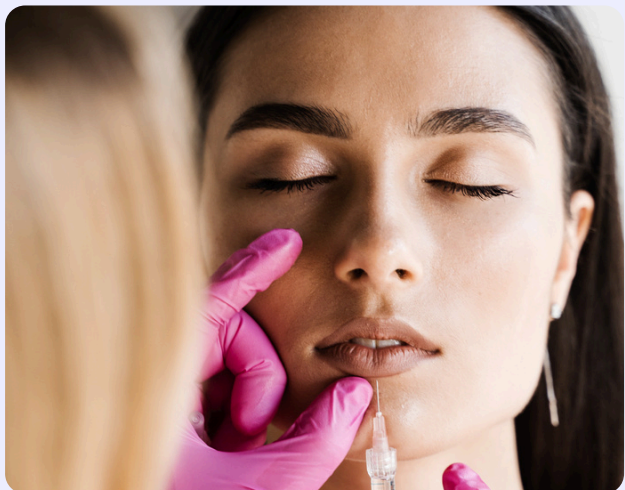
